5. **PARKING** – A friendly reminder that:

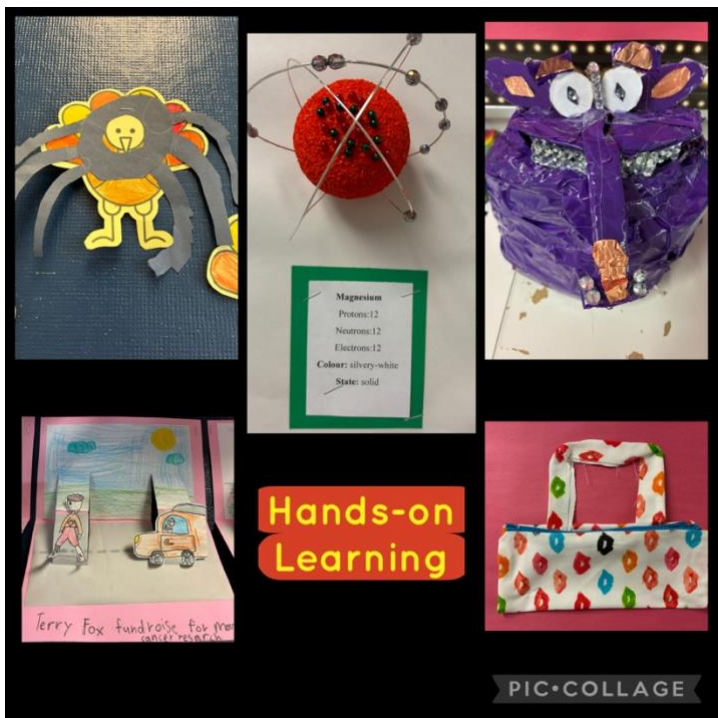


- a. Please do not park in staff parking – this includes the small lot at the ELC (north end of the building)
