2. **Remembrance Day Ceremony – PLEASE NOTE TIME CHANGE** - We will be having our Remembrance Day Ceremony on Monday, November 10th at 10:25am - ish. Parents are welcome, but there is limited seating. **Please note:** Recess will be changed for Monday only. Recess will be 10:00 – 10:15am. Students will enter then gym asap. Once we are all settled the ceremony will begin. **Parents – the doors to the Gym will open at 10:10am. Please walk, if possible, and wait outside of the building to line up.** This is a formal ceremony, and we ask students who are in girl guides, cadets, etc. to feel free to wear their uniforms. Kindly arrive on time and be sure to turn off cell phones. This is a somber assembly, and students are taught that we do not clap for this ceremony.



Students are encouraged to make a donation for their poppy. All donations go directly to Richmond Poppy Funds. Donations can be brought on Monday morning. Students will put their poppies on just before the ceremony.

We will have student ushers at the main Gym doors accepting donations from parents who ask for a poppy.

3. The **cold and flu season** is definitely upon us. Kindly keep your child at home if they are really sick and have a fever. VCH recommends that if a child has vomited, to stay home for 24-48 hours before returning to school. Let’s all work together to keep our community healthy!



4. PARKING – A friendly reminder that:

- a. Please do not park in staff parking – this includes the small lot at the ELC (north end of the building)
- b. **The lane closest to the school is for drop-off only. This means drivers should not park their car and get out.** Drivers must stay in their car and drop their child off only. If you need to park, you can park on the opposite side of the loop. We also need to keep this lane available for when the school buses arrive.
- c. Please do not park in the alley way. Please be considerate of our neighbors as they cannot get out of their driveways.
